

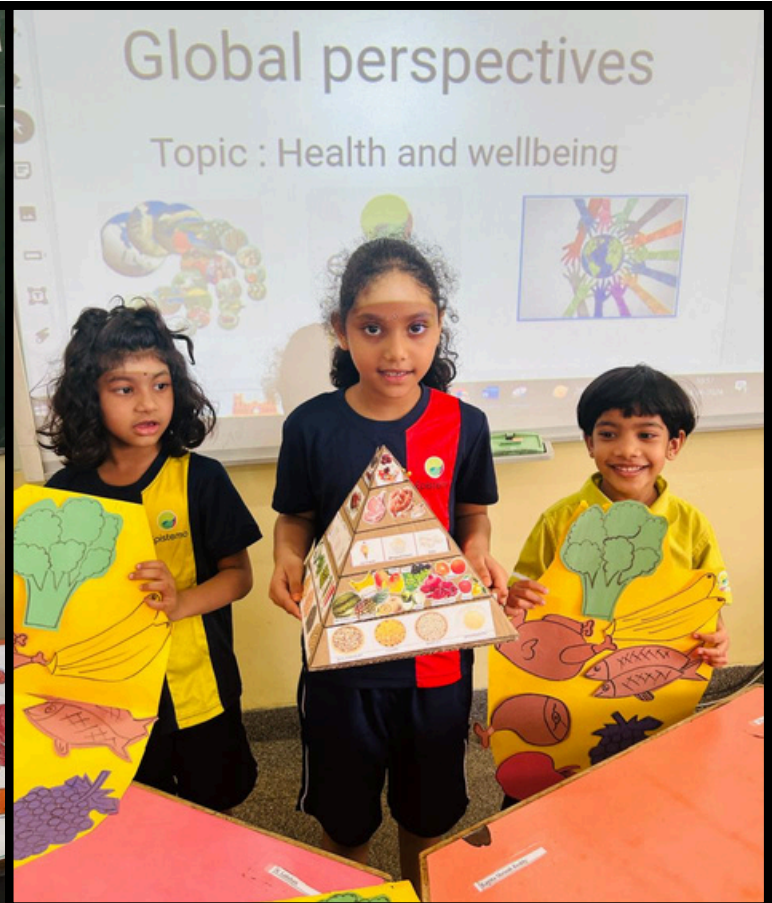




# Important School Events

### Sports and Recreation

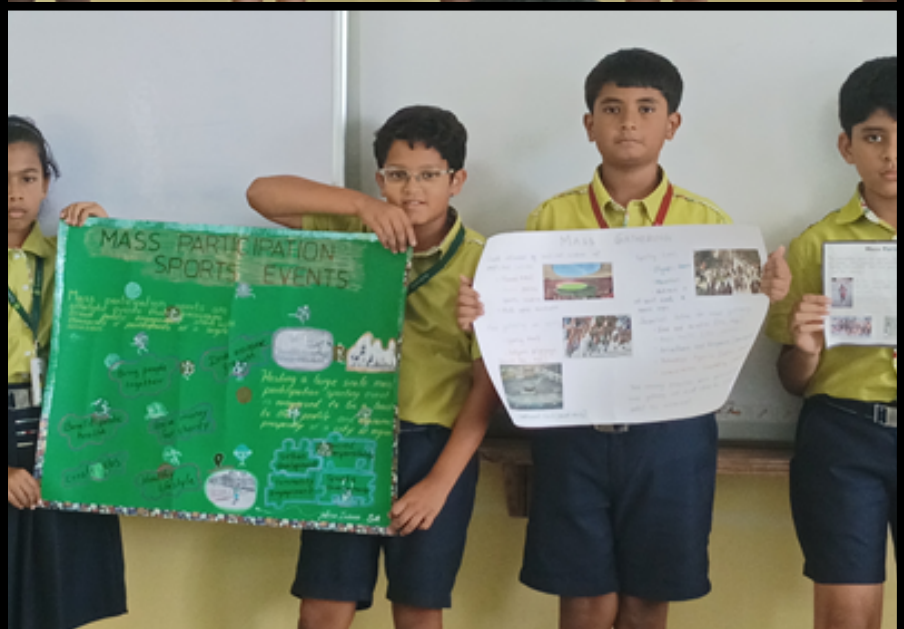
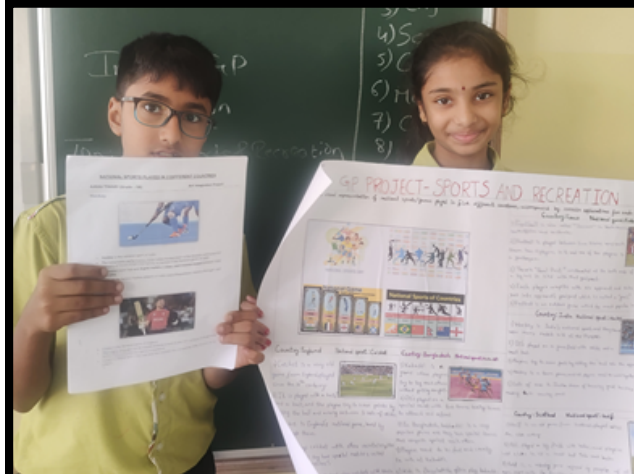
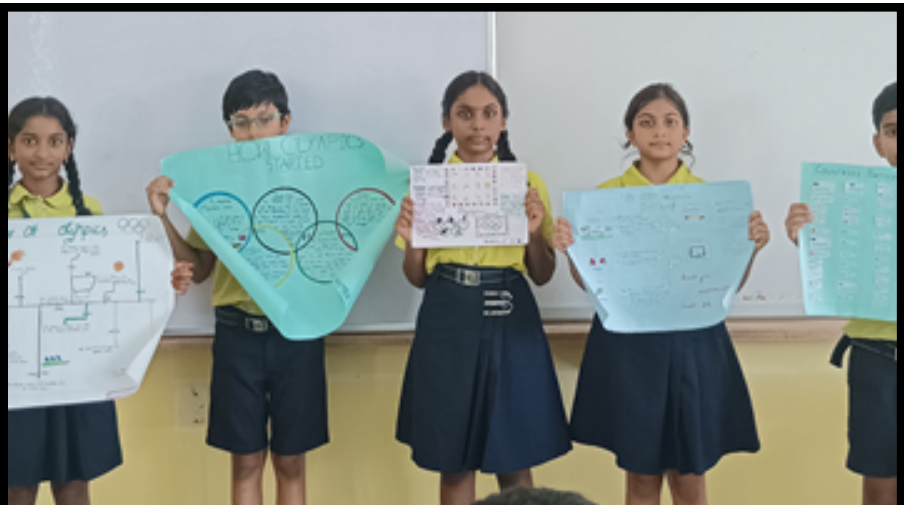
**Explores the World of Sports and Recreation:**

#### Project Overview:

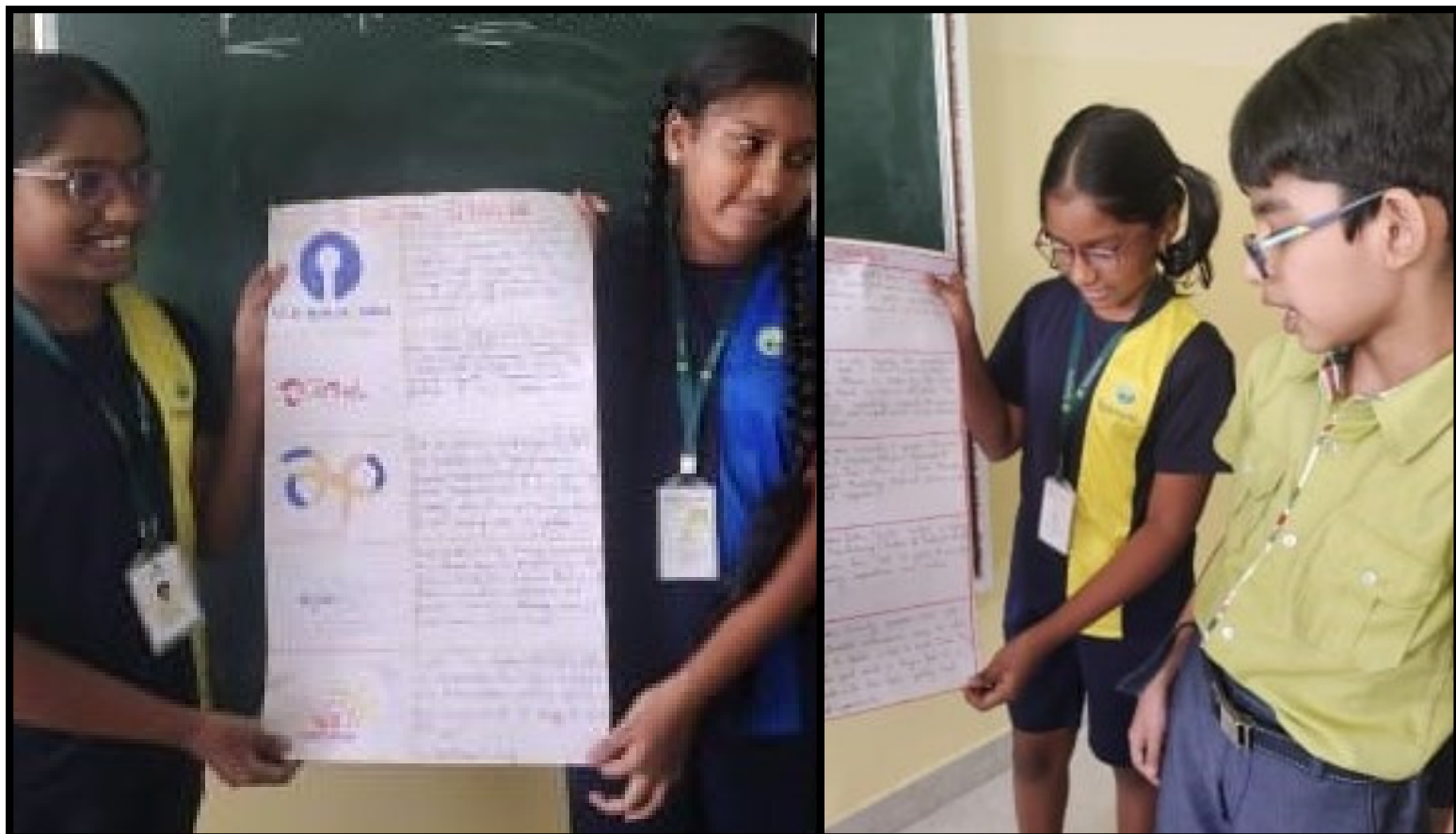
The project began with- what globalization means, highlighting its positive and negative aspects. Students learned how global brands operate and the role they play in connecting different parts of the world.
